Who was Prophet Jesus (A.S.) ?

1. Jesus (A.S.) had been given two names ISA and MASIH.
2. Jesus (A.S.) had been given two titles RUH and KALIMAH.
3. Jesus (A.S.) has been addressed in the Quran as ISA BIN MARYAM.
4. Jesus (A.S.) has been mentioned by his name in the Quran 25 times.
5. The Quran has dedicated a whole chapter in the Quran to his mother Mary.
6. The period between the prophet hood of Jesus (A.S.) and Muhammad (S.A.W.) was 570 years.

Miracles of Prophet Jesus (A.S.)

قَالَ إِنِّي عَبْدُ اللَّهِ ءَاتَنِي الْكِتَابَ وَجَعَلَنِي نَبِيًّا

[Jesus] said, "Indeed, I am the servant of Allah . He has given me the Scripture and made me a prophet.

1. Miracle birth.
2. Heal people of their illness.
3. Bring the dead back to life again.
4. Prophet Jesus (A.S.) would make a bird out of clay and breathe life into it by the will of Allah.
5. The ascent of prophet Jesus to the skies (3-55).

The similarities between Muhammad (S.A.W.) and Isa (A.S.)

1. The Prophet Muhammad (S.A.W.) saved the first generation of this nation from evil and Prophet Isa (A.S.) will save the last generation of this nation from evil.
2. Both Isa (A.S.) AND Muhammad (S.A.W.) were deprived of fatherly love and care.
3. Both Prophets were given Books by Allah.
4. Both Prophets were supported by Ruh-ul-Qudus (Gabriel)
5. They both possessed the quality of mercy and peace.
6. The burial place of both prophets is in Madinah.
